COURT REPORTER TRAINING (VOICE)

WHAT IS A COURT REPORTER?

A court reporter is a state-certified stenographer authorized to take down the verbatim testimony of witnesses in court or in pretrial depositions. The court reporter puts the witness under oath, records the testimony by stenographic means, and produces a certified transcript for the court.

A court reporter in Louisiana must pass a written certification exam and three skills tests ranging from 180 to 225 words per minute for five minutes.

WHAT EQUIPMENT IS NEEDED?

The hardware and software components of the program are as follows:

- Computer
- Stenomask or microphone
- Speech Recognition Software
- Computer-Aided Transcription (CAT) Software

BRSCR will load student CAT software. Refer to the web site for specific technology requirements. E-mail and Internet access are also required.

HOW LONG IS THE PROGRAM?

The Voice Writing program consists of a combination of 12 academic and applied courses.

The program takes approximately nine (9) months to complete the academics and achieve sufficient speedbuilding level(s).
